

## Canadian Grant Registry

### Sponsor Services

The Canadian Grant Registry (CGR) is an excellent tool for government Grant program professionals. It offers a range of valuable online services including program announcements, public and private program directories, central applicant registry, prospecting, award announcements, publication of success stories, target demographics, and performance statistics.

### Automatic Publication of Programs

Through the CGR website the task of publishing program notices, award notices, and success stories becomes easy. An advanced program management portal and secure database allows program staff to create and maintain an inventory of programs including descriptions, eligibility, program availability dates, contacts, and much more. Program announcements can not only be published automatically to public web sites, but also changed dynamically.

When funds are awarded, or projects completed, award notices and success stories are tracked and can be published in the form of award announcements. A geo-mapping feature allows for the display of award activity by region and electoral district.

### Central and Departmental Directories

Through CGR sponsor services program professionals have the option of publishing their programs to a public registry or publishing departmental directories on a departments own web site. Directories may be organized for browsing by subject index, organization, program or region. Advanced search features allow users to find programs by keyword and applicant profile. Program directories can be updated through an browser and may be secured and shared by individual program officer or authorized groups.

### Information and Feedback

When accessing the CGR website, prospective applicants have access to email communication between designated program representatives. Through this service applicants can pose questions or offer useful feedback when access the program directory.

### Profile Matching

The CGR website offers advanced services to prospective applicants to assist them in the search for suitable grant programs. The MyGrants service, for example, allows applicants to create a profile of their organization which is automatically matched to programs registered in the CGR database. This service is available interactively, or through email notification when a match is found between an applicant and new programs as they are registered.

### Online Screening Surveys

Increasing the number of qualified applicants and reducing the number of ineligible applicants can be very beneficial to grant programs and is made possible through self-service screening. Online survey forms can be made available to interested applicants allowing applicants to self-assess suitability for a given program. Screening surveys minimize the expensive and time consuming processing of unnecessary applications.

Program managers can optionally select the screening survey option which automatically generates a survey form which may be evaluated on pre-defined mandatory and rated criteria. Summary statistics on the success or failure of applicant assessments will be providing useful feedback to the eligibility review process.

### Online Advertising

Grant program sponsors may choose to take advantage of the CGR website's high visibility by advertising new program announcements or recent awards and successes. The CGR offers a range of advertising banner services to meet your needs.

### Forms on Demand

Program delivery is made easier by providing a self-service online forms directory for published programs. Program officers can manage and publish program related documents including application instructions, online application forms, etc. for self-service selection by prospective applicants. This Forms on Demand feature is designed to work with any internet browser making the task of electronic forms distribution easier than ever.
